

The Rehoboth Trust - Application for a grant

The Rehoboth Trust is registered charity with a Christian ethos run entirely by volunteers. It a grant making body with objects:

- a) The advancement of the Christian religion
- b) The relief of financial hardship, sickness or old age of people who are Christians or have dedicated their life to Christianity through missionary work in particular by the provision of financial assistance or accommodation.

Eligibility criteria

1. The Trust supports individuals and organisations based mainly in Wales;
2. Individuals should be evangelical Christians;
3. Organisations should be engaged in the advancement of the gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ;
4. Grants under Object b) by reason of age will be to those aged 65 or over;
5. Priority will be given to individuals and organisations on their area basis.
 - a. The first priority will be accorded to applicants based in Newport, South Wales;
 - b. The next priority will then be accorded to those in the combined area of Monmouthshire, Torfaen, Blaenau Gwent and Caerphilly and
 - c. The next priority will be accorded to those in the rest of Wales.

When should applications be made?

Applications will be considered in March, June, September and December. To be considered, an application should be received by the Treasurer by the 15th of the preceding month. Applicants will be notified of the Trustees' decision within eight weeks of the closing date for applications.

Other notes:

1. The Trustees' decision is final and correspondence will not be entered into regarding decisions.
2. Applications that do not meet the criteria or are received outside of the application date will not normally receive a response.
3. Receipts for expenditure may be requested.
4. Re-application to the Trust cannot be made within 12 months of a prior application.
5. Application for a grant for an individual will require a response from a nominated referee.
